For instance, it is the #1 city for shared mobility in Europe.

It is no surprise that Vilnius receives numerous awards at the fDi award ceremony during MIPIM each year. This year, Vilnius has been nominated for ten awards, including #2 for business friendliness, economic potential, FDI strategy, and life quality, #3 for business friendliness, and overall #2 mid-sized city of the future.

As a fast-growing city, Vilnius is transforming entire neighborhoods according to the Vilnius Method, offering potential investors exciting opportunities to be a part of the change. At MIPIM this year, the railway station territory, new central business district development, and projects such as Releven will be presented both as concrete and conceptual developments.
